# RARITAN POST OFFICE RENAMED

Congressman Leonard Lance (NJ-07) secured passage in the U.S. House of Representatives his legislation H.R. 2815, that designates the U.S. Post Office in Raritan, New Jersey, as the "Gunnery Sergeant John Basilone Post Office." In a speech before colleagues in the House of Representatives, Congressman Lance recounted the many honors Basilone earned in service to the country.

Basilone was the only Marine of World War II to receive both the Medal of Honor and the Navy Cross.

# Somerset County Ranked 3rd Healthiest in NJ

For the third year in a row, Somerset County has been ranked third-healthiest county in New Jersey based on a nationwide survey conducted by the University of Wisconsin in collaboration with the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation.

The success is attributable in large part to the efforts of the County Department of Health and their focus on engaging county residents and stakeholders in good health habits and promoting policy changes to improve health and well-being.

Construction is scheduled to begin in Spring, 2019.

## REGIONAL CENTER Partnership Awards Pedestrian Safety Enhancement Grants

The Regional Center Partnership has awarded Pedestrian Safety Enhancement Challenge Grants to the three communities. Grants were made available for up to \$15,000 per community.

Raritan will receive funds for police to partner with RideWise to implement an eight-week pedestrian safety education and enforcement campaign along West Somerset Street. An additional project will improve traffic striping at various locations.

Somerville will receive funds for signage improvements at crosswalks near the middle and high schools. Police will partner with RideWise to provide in-school pedestrian and bike safety education.

Bridgewater will upgrade Townshipowned traffic signals along Commons Way at Garretson Road, Fifth Street, Prince Rodgers Avenue, and Crossings Boulevard to include pedestrian crossing signals and countdown times.
