RAIN BARREL REBATES AVAILABLE TO REGIONAL CENTER HOMEOWNERS

Utilizing a grant from the New Jersey Water Supply Authority (NJWSA), the 2019 Raritan River Rain Barrel Rebate Program for homeowners in Bridgewater, Raritan, and Somerville is available for the 9th year.

Rebates are available in the amount of \$50 for 40 to 70-gallon rain barrels and \$100 for those that hold more than 70 gallons. Rebates are available for multiple rain barrels that meet all criteria.

Rain barrels provide homeowners with financial and ecological advantages by conserving water, easing stream erosion and reducing pollutants accumulated from impervious surfaces, particularly roofs.

Raritan's Alternatives, Inc. has announced that the New Jersey Division of Vocational Rehabilitation Services has renewed the contract for Alternative's Career Development Center for the next three years. The program provides services for people who are hearing impaired and seeking employment.

REGIONAL CENTER MAYORS JOIN "BUILD GATEWAY NOW COALITION"

Regional Center Mayors Hayes, McMullin, and Sullivan have joined other Raritan Valley Line Mayors Alliance members in support of the "Build Gateway Now Coalition." The organization advocates for building the Gateway Tunnel and establishing a 1-seat ride on the Raritan Valley Line into New York's Penn Station during peak, off-peak, and weekend hours.

SOMERVILLE PROPOSING EMERGENCY SERVICES COMPLEX

Somerville is investigating the potential for consolidation of emergency services on a 1.77 acre property on North Gaston Avenue. The property is owned by the Borough, having been purchased in February of 2018 for \$1.4 million.

The Borough is now determining the scope, budget, and schedule for the project that will house the police department and consolidate three fire houses.

FAR HILLS RACE MEETING & RWJUH SOMERSET PARTNER FOR COMMUNITY SUPPORT

The Far Hills Race Meeting Association and Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital Somerset (RWJUHS) have announced a partnership to invest in community health programs.



Through this partnership, \$885,000 in grants has been awarded to five non-profits serving northern Somerset County. The funds will be distributed over the next three years. Additionally RWJUHS will support the selected organizations with professional training, community health education, support groups, and other health care services.
