BRIDGEWATER ENDS PROHIBITION-ERA RESTRICTION

Bridgewater Township Council voted to end part of the alcohol beverage ordinance dating back to the repeal of the 18th Amendment that prohibited the purchase of alcoholic beverages to be made on credit.

LAUREL CIRCLE REVITALIZATION PLAN

Laurel Circle (formerly Arbor Glen) on Monroe Street in Bridgewater has announced an \$8 million revitalization plan at the senior community.

Improvements include a new outpatient clinic, new gym equipment, an upgraded front lobby, and more.

Laurel Circle is owned and operated by Des Moines-based LCS that is also building The Delaney on Frontier Road in Bridgewater featuring 223 residences.

UNCLE JULIO'S OPENS IN BRIDGEWATER

Uncle Julio's, serving made-fromscratch Mexican cuisine, has opened in the Bridgewater Commons. The restaurant is in the location that formerly housed McCormick & Schmicks. The restaurant will offer both indoor and outdoor dining.

TOUR OF SOMERVILLE ADDS GRAN FONDO

A new addition to the Memorial Day Tour of Somerville will be the Gran Fondo (Italian for "Big Ride").

The noncompetitive recreational bicycle ride will depart from Division Street at 8:00 A.M. on Sunday, May 24, 2020.

Two routes will be offered, a Skillman Park Ride of 41 miles with no major



climbs and the Colonial Park Ride of 17 miles, suitable for novice riders.

ORACLE EXPANDS PRESENCE IN BRIDGEWATER

Oracle will be expanding its software operations team by relocating offices into a new renovated 17,000 square feet at the Somerset Corporate Center off Route 202/206 in Bridgewater.

Oracle is a multinational corporation that sells database software and technology, cloud engineer systems, and enterprise software products. The new facility will provide sales, consulting, education and support to regional customers.

SOMERVILLE SEEKS TRAFFIC CHANGES

To enhance public safety, the Somerville Borough Council has approved a concent resolution asking NJDOT to reduce the speed limit on Route 28 in the Borough from 35 MPH to 25 MPH on West End Avenue, West and East Main Streets, North Gaston Avenue, and Union Avenue.

In addition, Mayor Dennis Sullivan has asked the Motor Vehicle Commission (MVC) Chief Administrator to immediately close the Roosevelt Place office on Saturdays due to the regular disruptions experienced in the residential neighborhood.
